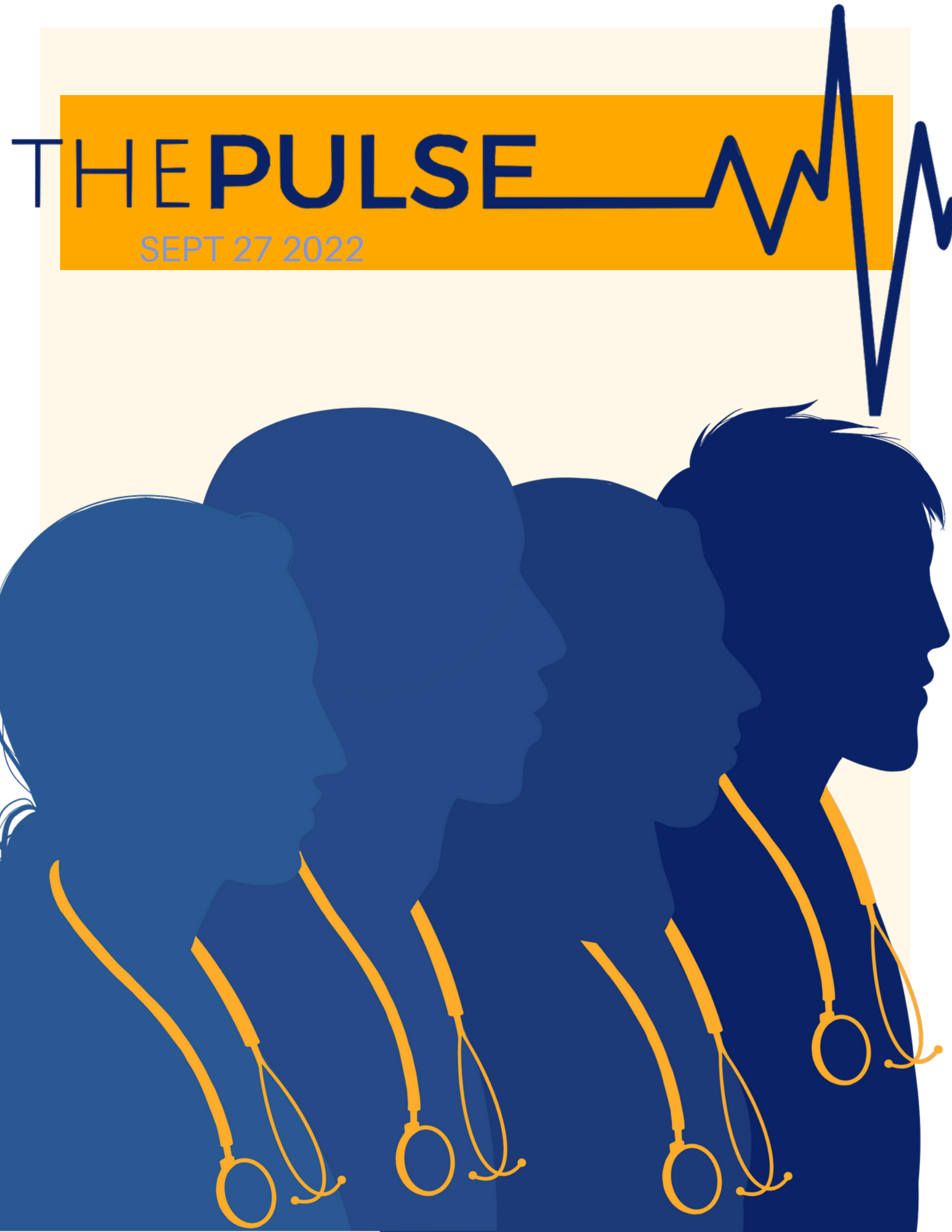

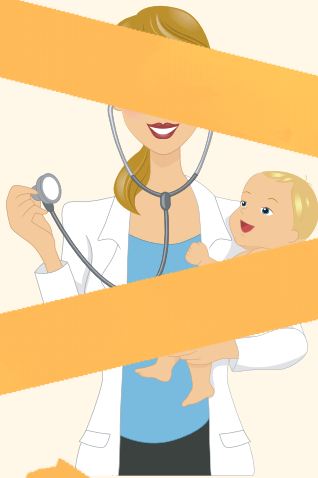
Cards 4 Care

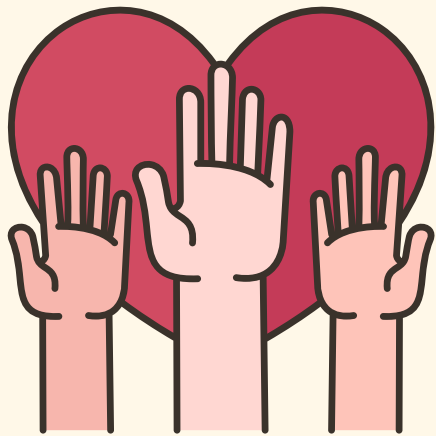


IM Football
